Important Dates:

Book return and new textbook request orders:

Due by July 1

Late Returns will incur a \$5 per book fee

Textbook pickup:

August 15 and 16 from 8:00 am - 1:00 pm

August 17 from 8:00 am - 6:00 pm

How to Order Textbooks

Step 1: Verify textbooks are RIDE approved

Visit the [Rhode Island Department of Education website](#) and enter in the information for each textbook. *Only textbooks that are approved by the Rhode Island Department of Education can be provided.*

Step 2: Submit your textbook(s) request

Fill out online textbook request form or *download a hard copy form (pdf) below.*

The textbook title, author, publisher, copyright date, and ISBN number MUST be entered for each textbook. Each student will need a separate form.

Step 3: Pick up your textbooks

August 15 & 16 from 8:00 am - 1:00 pm or

August 17 from 8:00 am - 6:00 pm

at **East Bay Educational Collaborative**

317 Market Street, Warren (*enter via the side entrance under the covered walkway*)

NOTE: Proof of Residency is required for first time program participants

Proof of residency must be presented for first time participants in the textbook loan program. The following documents will be accepted as proofs of residency: Property Tax Bill, Current license and Registration, Utility Bill (Phone, Electric, Gas or Cable/Internet)
