Dear Parent/Guardian:

The North Providence School Department will furnish textbooks for North Providence residents attending non-public schools for the 2018-2019 school year. Books may be borrowed in Mathematics, Science, Modern Foreign Languages, English/Language Arts and History/Social Studies for grades K-12. The textbooks must be on a list published by the Commissioner of Education entitled the *List of Textbooks Approved for Loan to Non-Public School Students*.

To facilitate the ordering of books, order forms are enclosed. Extra forms will be available at the Birchwood Middle School, 10 Birchwood Drive, North Providence, RI during the ordering period. Those requesting textbooks must provide the correct title, author, publisher, copyright date, and ISBN number for each textbook. You will be asked to provide proof of residency to ensure that books are only loaned to North Providence residents.

More importantly, all textbooks borrowed last year **must** be returned before this year's request will be honored. All damaged and lost books **must** be paid for before placing new textbook orders. The cost of replacing a book is the list price plus a three dollar (\$3) shipping and handling charge. In order to make certain textbooks requested arrive by the beginning of the school year, all requests must be in by July 18, 2018. **THE NORTH PROVIDENCE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REQUESTS MADE AFTER THIS DATE.**

The return/ordering and distribution of books will take place at the Birchwood Middle School. The dates of return/ordering and distribution are as follows:
