RE: TEXTBOOK LOAN

Prior to the close of school, please notify students from Smithfield/Greenville of the following procedure for ordering books for the 2019-2020 school year, as well as returning books currently out on loan from the Smithfield School Department.

SMITHFIELD TEXTBOOK LOAN PROGRAM FOR NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

Non-public school students who are residents of Smithfield may apply online for loan of textbooks in Mathematics, Foreign Language, Science, English, and Social Studies for Grades K-12.

Please notify students that all books to be ordered for the 2019-2020 school year should be ordered on our website www.smithfield-ps.org.

The Textbook Loan Office, located at 49 Farnum Pike, will be open for the return of books borrowed on the following dates from 8:30 am to 2:30pm

Thursday June 13, 2019
Friday June 14, 2019
Monday June 17, 2019

Books from the previous school year must be returned or paid for before any new books will be issued. Proof of Residency is required to borrow books. Requested textbooks must be on the State Approved List. A list of all approved books can be found on the RIDE website at www.eride.ri.gov/eride2k5/TextbookInventory. All books must be ordered through the Smithfield School Department. No reimbursements will be made for books purchased privately.

Students must have the following information for each book:

TITLE, AUTHOR, PUBLISHER, ISBN #, AND COPYRIGHT DATE.

Please inform students that mid-year requests for Class changes will not be honored.

PRINCIPALS: If you have not already done so, please send this office a list of textbooks to be used by your school for the 2019-2020 school year. It is important that students know what they need for the courses they will be taking in the Fall.
