

Service Project Requirements

1. **Service Hour Forms** (which record the hours of service performed) are due by the last day of classes in April for all students. Forms submitted in May will only receive 50%; forms submitted in June will receive only 25%. Completion of hours count as 1 test grade to be input the last day of classes in June.
2. **Service Reflection Projects** will be due no later May 1st for all students. Completion of the project counts as 1 test grade to be input the last day of classes in June. Rubrics will be given to students at the beginning of the school year.
3. **Classroom Presentations** will be presented no later than May. Students will be presenting projects throughout the school year to share service opportunities with their peers. Presentations count as 1 test grade.

Students who do not perform service will receive a zero for their hours, their project, and their presentation, equivalent to 3 test grades.

Freshmen Reflection Project: Power Point Presentation

- 7 slides
- 2 slides that include pictures of you completing your service (you MUST be in the photo: be mindful of where you serve and their guidelines about photographs)
- 3 slides with 1 paragraph of 5 to 7 sentences (each) of reflection, including
 - 1 slide: A summary of your service
 - 1 slide: What you learned about yourself through your service experience
 - 1 slide: What your favorite part of your service experience was and why
- 2 slides with scripture that relates to your service – 1 slide with scripture from the Old Testament and 1 slide with scripture from the New Testament; these must be properly cited (Book, Chapter, Verse)

Sophomore Reflection Project: Create a newspaper article

- Include 2 photos (you MUST be in the photos: be mindful of where you serve and their guidelines about photographs)
- Answer the questions in your article:
 - Who did you serve? Where did you serve? What did you do?
 - Why did you choose this service?
 - Why is this service necessary?
 - How did the service experience affect you?
- A template will be provided.

Junior Reflection Project: Comprehensive Service Reflection Paper about ALL past service (incorporates 9, 10, and 11 grade)

- Paper: 5 paragraph essay that answers this prompt: Why is community service important?
- You must include the following in your paper:
 - Body Paragraph #1: Provide 3 examples (one for each year of service) of how you have seen the Lasallian Mission alive through your service.
 - Body Paragraph #2: How are your service experiences related to the respect of human dignity?
 - Body Paragraph #3: How have your service experiences prepared you for serving others in the future?

Senior Reflection Project: Video

- Create a video (2-3 minutes).
- Your video should include:
 - Footage/Pictures of you completing your service. (be mindful of where you serve and their guidelines about photographs)
 - An appropriate instrumental song (as background) for the footage/pictures.
 - Narration of you reflecting on your service.
 - Who did you serve? Where did you serve? What did you do?
 - Why did you choose this service? Why is this service necessary?
 - How did the service experience affect you?
