Let me begin by saying how appreciative I am to everyone who has supported Saint Raphael Academy during the last year. Put simply, your kindness and generosity have transformed the lives of our students. The Academy has enjoyed tremendous success during the last several years (increased student enrollment, renovated facilities, improved technology, etc.), and that doesn't happen without the gifts and prayers from our alumni and supporters.

I often speak to many prospective families and their 8th grade students during this time of the year. I always end my discussion with the well-known adage of, "It takes a village to raise a child." I further elaborate that in my metaphor, SRA is that village. We are the perfect size. Our Academy is big enough to offer 10 AP classes, to coach the top 800-meter runner in the country (see page 3), and to boast the top drama program in the state of Rhode Island (see page 2). At the same time, we are small enough where the typical incoming 9th grade student is nurtured and encouraged to become involved at the Academy in a variety of ways. After being here only several weeks, our new 9th grader knows his classmates, his teachers and the school administration. But more importantly, the child's classmates, teachers and administrators will know him. Does this sound familiar to your experience at Saints? Over the decades, the names and faces may have changed at SRA, but our mission and how we relate to our students remain constant.

With the support of our wonderful alumni, we have once again upgraded our beautiful campus. We are currently in the



process of acquiring the Christian Brothers residence at 193 Walcott Street (the former rectory of Saint Joseph's Church). Our plans for the use of this building haven't yet been determined but I am very grateful to the Brothers for their continuous support of Saint Raphael Academy! Expect more detailed plans to be announced soon.

We have enjoyed another amazing year at the Academy. Our student enrollment continues to be the best in the Diocese of Providence, and we are sending our graduates to many of the top universities in the country (including Brown and West Point). The future of our school looks extremely promising and with your assistance, we get better every year. 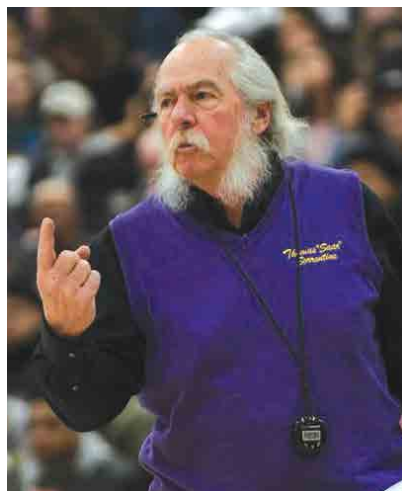
Out of 20 athletic teams made playoff or higher levels. The boys volleyball team (featured on the cover) was the state D-3 champion.

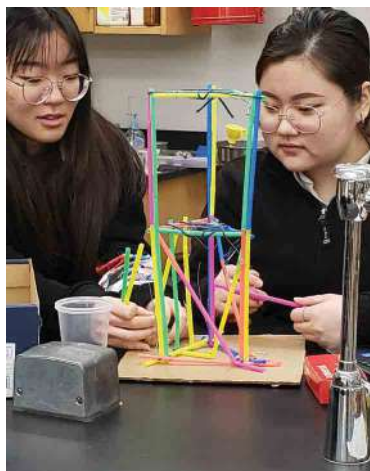
